Published in 1847, this novel became the most successful book of that year. The story follows the life of the title character, Jane Eyre. Brontë tells the story of Jane, including her growth into adulthood and her love for Mr. Rochester. *Jane Eyre* was immediately successful then and is still very popular.

Charlotte was not the only author in her family. Her two sisters, Emily and Anne, were writers as well. Emily is well-known for writing the classic *Wuthering Heights*. Anne was also successful with her novel *Agnes Grey*.
